



WOBBLE DANCE WORLD RECORD ATTEMPT

Des Moines Water Works Park | May 21, 2022, 12 PM - 2PM

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Where is the event being held?

- a. The Wobble World Record Attempt will be at Water Works Park in Des Moines at the White Amphitheater 2201 George Flagg Parkway Des Moines, IA 50321. It is right across from Grays Lake.

2. What do I bring to the event?

- a. Bring your friends, family, neighbors, or anyone else that would like to be a world record holder! There will be water bottle filling stations on site, so bring your water bottle!
- b. If you would like to bring your lawn chair, please note that chairs will not be allowed in the Wobble Dancing area. Remember you will be responsible for anything you bring to the event.

3. Where do I park?

- a. Upon arrival, there will be parking attendants there to guide you. You will be able to park your car in the parking lot behind the administration building as well as grass parking lots.

4. How do I check in?

- a. When you arrive, you will be directed to the registration table where you will receive your official bracelet and button. Then you will be instructed on how to line up for the dance. This may take a while because of the number of people.

5. What if I don't know the dance?

- a. That is okay! We have instructors that can teach you in about two minutes. We will give tutorials before the record attempt starts.

6. What is the schedule for the day?

- a. The schedule is posted on the website, but there will also be volunteers with information on site for any specifics.

7. What if I am a part of a team?

- a. Make sure you check in at the registration table to get your official bracelet and button. Then find the rest of your team. Stay close to them until the official attempt begins.

8. What are the COVID precautions?

- a. The event is outside for social distancing. Mask wearing is at your discretion. Please bring your own sanitizer.

9. How long is the song?

- a. The "Wobble" song by VIC is 5 minutes long.

10. Do I have to stay the whole time?

- a. We request that you stay until the completion of the official attempt which should be before 1:30 PM.

11. What if I didn't register online?

- a. That's no problem! Everyone is welcome to come and break a world record for Iowa. Just make sure you check in at the registration table to get your official bracelet and button.
